

Dragonflies

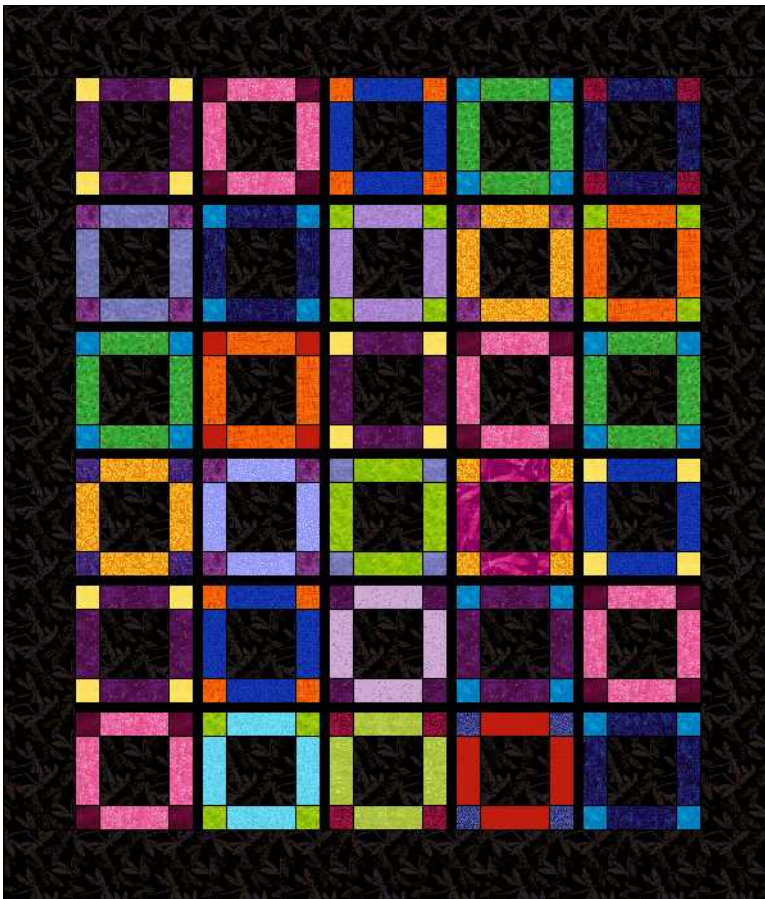
Quilt Size 49 x 56.75

Block size is 7 inches (7.5 inches with seam allowance)

Blocks are set 5 x 6

Quilt Notes

To make it appear that the blocks are floating on the quilt top, pick a focus fabric with a black background for the block centers and border and use tone on tone fabrics for your block frames. A solid black fabric should be used for the narrow sashing between blocks. See my quilt photo as an example.



Cutting

Narrow black sashing between the blocks is cut 1.25 inches

Border is cut 6 inches

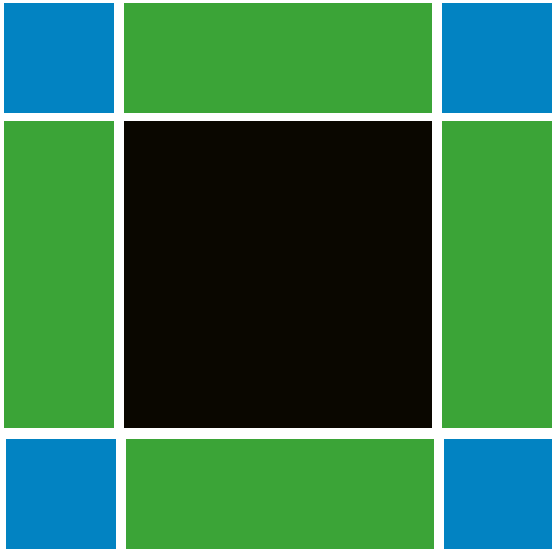
Block Cornerstones are cut 2 x 2 inches

Block frames are cut 2 x 4.5 inches

Center square is cut 4.5 x 4.5 inches (from the same fabric as the border)

Dragonflies

Sew block cornerstones to top and bottom framing fabric; sew sides to block centers and then sew the 3 sections together.



Quilt Assembly

Lay out 5 blocks across and 6 blocks down. Sew sashing to right side of the first 4 blocks in each row – the 5th block will not have a sashing strip – and sew blocks together in rows. Sew sashing strips in between rows. There is NO sash border. Once the blocks have all been sewn together - the print border is added.
