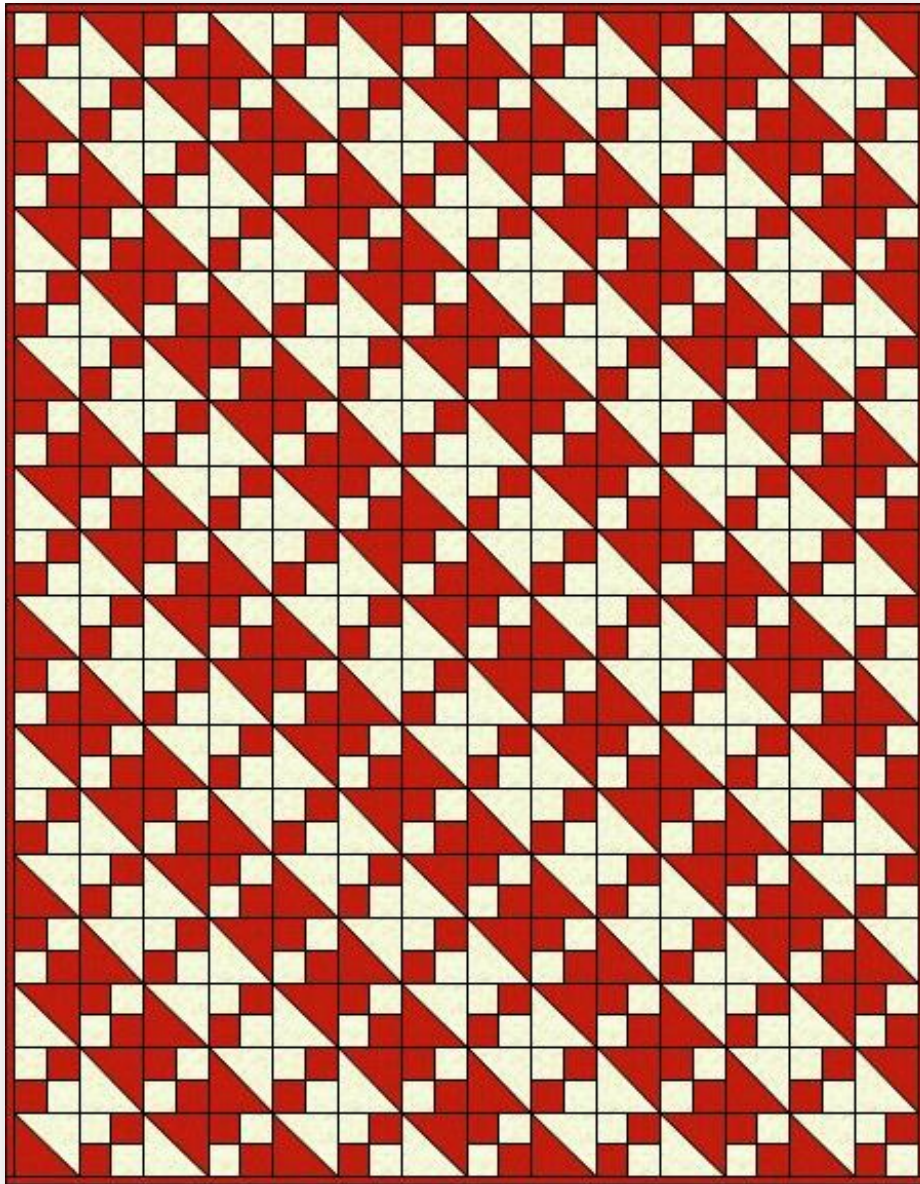


Red Rover

Quilt Size 56 x 72

Block size is 8 inches finished (8.5 inches with seam allowances)

Setting is 7 x 9 blocks



QUILT NOTES

- ✦ Although the above diagram shows the quilt in two colors, I used a variety of red and beige fabrics to make my quilt really scrappy. Use a variety of light fabrics ranging from white to tan for best results.
- ✦ My quilt is queen size (96x96) but the following instructions are for a lap size quilt - I'll post brief instructions for increasing it to queen size at the end.

BLOCK PIECING

Blocks are made up of four patches and half square triangles that are 4 inches (4.5 inches with seam allowances).

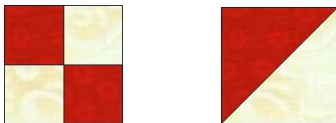
Cut your strips for the four patches 2.5 inches. I used short strips to have more variety in my four patches. Sew each red strip to a beige strip.



After cutting 2.5 inch segments from the strip sets; mix them up and sew the four patches using two different segments.



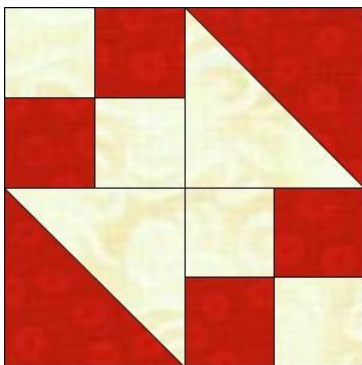
You may use any method you choose to make your half square triangle blocks – I used Thangles that finished at 4 inches (4.5 with seam allowances) .



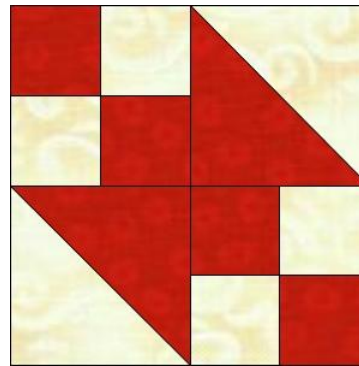
You will need 126 half square triangles and 126 four patches to assemble Block A and Block B below.

Pay **close attention** to how the blocks are rotated below.

BLOCK A – MAKE 32



BLOCK B – MAKE 31



ASSEMBLE TOP

Looking at the diagram on page 1 - lay out blocks 7 across and 9 rows down – you will alternate Block A and Block B.

Odd number rows will start with Block A

Even number rows will start with Block B

QUEEN SIZE VERSION

QUILT SIZE IS 96 X 96

SET BLOCKS 12 X 12

You will need 288 four patches and 288 half square triangle blocks.

↳ Block A – Make 72

↳ Block B – Make 72

Odd number rows will start with Block A

Even number rows will start with Block B

Assembling the blocks in groups of four as shown below may help when assembling the larger version of this quilt.
