
## Rectangles

Quilt size - 40x56 Block size - 8 inches ( 8.5 with seam allowances) Set blocks 5 x 7

Rectangles are 2.5 inches by 4.5 inches

I have a GO die that cuts rectangles this size and I used it for the Bright Rectangle quilt




This quilt is also Jelly Roll or 2.5 inch strip friendly and you can get two blocks from each strip (plus your background fabric) so you need (18) 2.5 inch strips x width of fabric PLUS about a yard and a half of background fabric. I like to have a little cushion ... technically if you do the math, you'd only need 44 inches of background fabric plus some for straightening the edges of the fabric. The Blue Green Rectangle quilt was made from 2.5 inch strips.



I sewed one background strip to a colored strip and cut sections that were 4.5 inches from that strip-set. Four sections were sewn together for each block... each strip set made two blocks.

## Make 35 blocks
