
Boxed Squares

Quilt Size is 48 x 60 Block Size is 6 inches (6.5 inches with seam allowances)



Quilt Notes

- 1 used a Jelly Roll that contained (40) 2.5 inch strips for this quilt. Each strip yielded two blocks.
- You may cut your own strips 2.5 inches. Strips can be cut from fat quarters along the 22 inch side which will give you one block per strip or WOF (width of fabric) which should give you 2 blocks per strip.
- ▶ I paired 2 strips with good contrast and cut them at the same time.

Cutting

I paired up two strips from the Jelly Roll and leaving them folded in half so I'm cutting through 4 layers, I cut - (2) 6.5 inch rectangles, (3) 2.5 inch squares. This gives me enough for 4 blocks - two of each color combination.



Arranging sections before sewing

Arrange 4 blocks as shown below and sew the inner 3 squares together first, and then add side rectangles.



You will piece 80 blocks.



Quilt Assembly

Assemble 4 blocks as show below, alternating the direction of the seams.



Once all the blocks are assembled into these 4 block sections (you will have 20), sew 4 across and 5 down to finish assembling the top.

Quilt size can be increased by adding additional blocks or borders.
